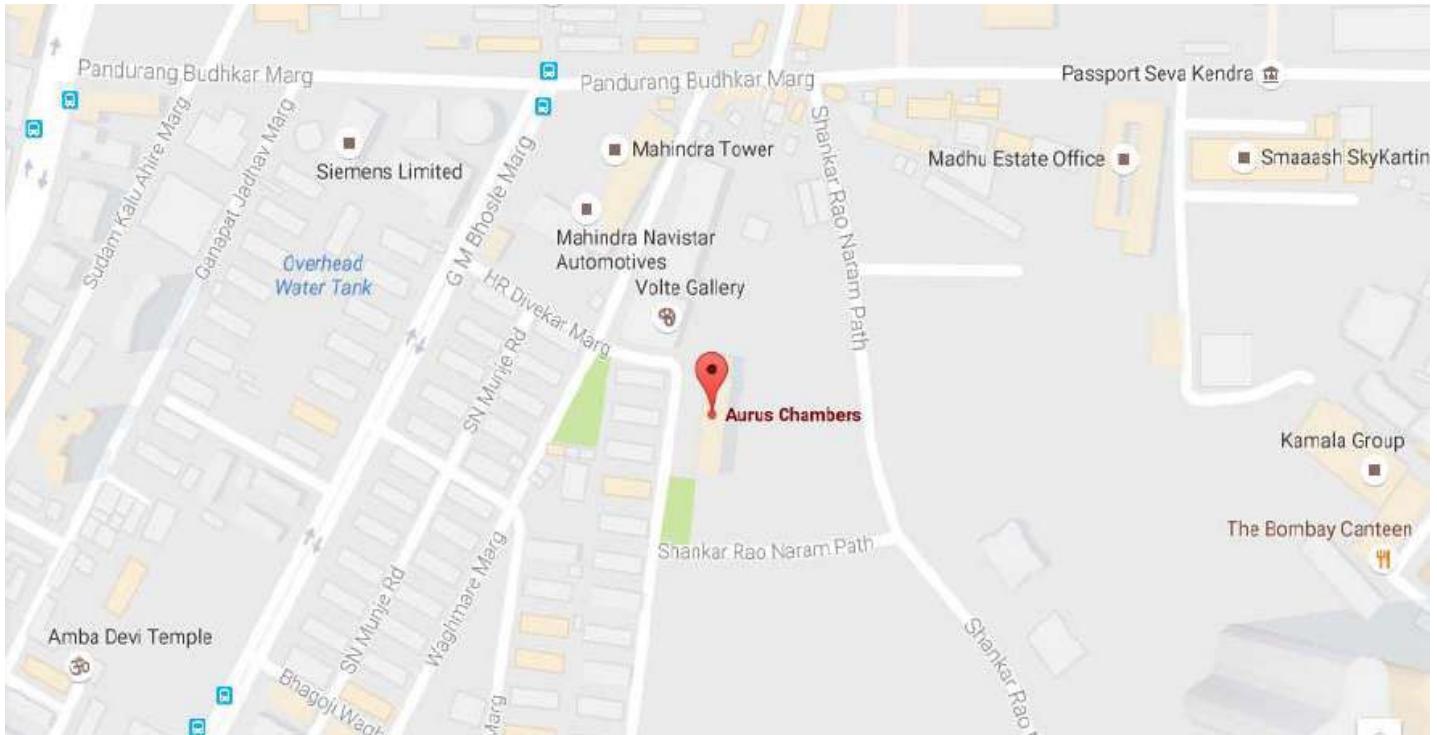

Shri Rupesh Anil Kadam is the Chief financial officer of the Company.

There was no appointment or resignation of any key managerial personnel.
